Class will be held at the Osage Ambulance Base located at 119 Highway 89 South in Linn.

The Emergency Medical Technician Course will prepare participants to be active providers of prehospital care for ill or injured patients. The EMT student will have an active classroom, lab, and skill experience. EMT students have mandatory ambulance clinical hours meeting patient contact requirements to complete the course. This course prepares the motivated participant for state and national testing. Passing these tests allows graduates to apply for a Missouri state license as an Emergency Medical Technician entering or advancing an amazing EMS career.

The Emergency Medical Responder course will prepare participants to be active First Responders to both medical and traumatic patient events, providing basic emergency care and stabilization to family, friends, co-workers, or strangers. Emergency Medical Responders are often Law Enforcement officers and Fire fighters. The information and skills are beneficial to those working in many areas, such as Construction, Industrial, Agricultural, Mechanical shops, or for anyone wanting knowledge to help others in a crisis. This course will have active classroom and lab activities. Ambulance clinical is highly suggested but not a requirement of this course.

No state / national testing or licensure in Missouri for EMR.

Both courses meet or exceed the education requirements as outlined by the Missouri Bureau of EMS and the United States Department of Transportation curriculum.
